What is the small, round skullcap worn by Catholic clergy (e.g., bishops, cardinals, the pope) called?

Worn by Catholic clergy since the 13th century, the round skullcap is called a zucchetto. Different colors indicate the rank of the wearer. For example, the pope wears a white zucchetto, while cardinals wear scarlet zucchetos, black zucchetos are worn by others such as abbots, and bishops' zucchetos are a violet color know as amaranth
